

Notice to Test Scoring Coordinators

Concerning the 2012 Mathematics Tests Scoring Materials

Some extraneous sample responses have been inadvertently included in the scoring materials that have been provided on the CD for Grades 4, 5, 6, and 7. To restore a seamless alignment between the materials provided in the scoring leader training documents with those in the scorer training documents, it is necessary that these extraneous pages be crossed out, either prior to being distributed to scorers or shortly after they have been handed out. If the scoring materials have not already been photocopied, the cross outs can be made prior to photocopying. If the photocopying has already been done, please have each scorer cross out the extraneous pages as described in this memo as a first step in the scorer training. Please note that if the scoring materials have been or will be printed single sided, the extraneous pages listed below can be either crossed out or removed.

Below is a list of changes that should be made to the scoring guides prior to scoring.

- Mathematics Grade 4 *Practice Set* (4MA-SG2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Sets 8 and 9 on pages 8 and 9. Then turn to the 4th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located at the end of the document (after page 55). On this key, draw a line through PS8 and PS9.
- Mathematics Grade 4 *2012 Scoring Leader Training Materials, Volume 2, Practice Set and Consistency Assurance Set* (4MA-VOL2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Sets 8 and 9 on pages 8 and 9. Then turn to the 4th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located after page 55 of the Practice Set portion of the guide. On this key, draw a line through PS8 and PS9.
- Mathematics Grade 5 *Practice Set* (5MA-SG2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Set 19 on page 19. Then turn to the 5th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located at the end of the document (after page 45). On this key, draw a line through PS19.
- Mathematics Grade 5 *2012 Scoring Leader Training Materials, Volume 2, Practice Set and Consistency Assurance Set* (5MA-VOL2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Set 19 on page 19. Then turn to the 5th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located on page 46. On this key, draw a line through PS19.

- Mathematics Grade 6 *Practice Set* (6MA-SG2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Set 40 on page 40. Next, change the numbering of Practice Set 39 on page 39 to be Practice Set 40. Then turn to the 6th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located on page 46. On this key, draw a line through PS39.
- Mathematics Grade 6 *2012 Scoring Leader Training Materials, Volume 2, Practice Set and Consistency Assurance Set* (6MA-VOL2) – Draw an “X” through Practice Set 39 on page 39. Then turn to the 6th Grade Math Practice Set Answer Key located after page 45 of the Practice Set portion of the guide. On this key, draw a line through PS39.
- Mathematics Grade 7 *2012 Consistency Assurance Set* (7MA-CAS) – Draw an “X” through CAS 9 on page 9. Then turn to the 7th Grade Math Consistency Assurance Set Answer Key located after page 10. On this key, draw a line through CAS 9.
- Mathematics Grade 7 *2012 Scoring Leader Training Materials, Volume 2, Practice Set and Consistency Assurance Set* (7MA-VOL2) – Find the 2012 Consistency Assurance Set section of the guide. Draw an “X” through CAS 9 on page 9. Then turn to the 7th Grade Math Consistency Assurance Set Key located after page 10 of the Consistency Assurance Set portion of the guide (last page of guide). On this key, draw a line through CAS 9.
