

Criteria for Judging Alternative Assessments

Criteria	Rationale
1. Valid	Must provide information about each child's achievement of objectives in each subject area.
2. Reliable	Must be replicable and fair measure of child's skills and knowledge.
3. Fair	Must be demonstrably fair for all children.
4. Fair Standard	Passing criteria are set in a valid way.
5. Equitable Forms	Every form of the test across years, administrations, and students must measure the same traits and be of equivalent difficulty.
6. Sensitivity	Must respect of dignity of children and all populations.
