Extension: Complete a function table. (e.g., fill in the input/output information) (91311)

Task: The student will complete a function table (e.g., given a function table with one or more value(s) missing, the student fills in the missing value(s). (AT91311)

Note: In this sample, the function table is kept very simple with the relationship of add one used. This is acceptable. Teachers have flexibility in designing the details of the activity, so that it is appropriate for the student. The notation indicates that the student was given an array of choices to select from, so that the student can make a selection without having to come up with the answers on his own. Also, the evidence for the Final is the same as the Baseline. This is acceptable, and may be considered a time-saver for teachers. Teachers should evaluate whether doing this is the best way to assess the student. Multiple opportunities were used to provide the student with multiple opportunities to respond; however, if appropriate for the student, the teacher could provide the student with only one row to complete. Doing so would limit the level of accuracy to zero percent or one hundred percent.
