Use this rubric to holistically score the short response to each of the Pre-Writing questions for all levels: 2-4, 5-6, 7-8, and 9-12. Look at the descriptions for the score points below. Use the key words in bold for each score point to help guide your decision.

SCORE POINT	DESCRIPTION
Score 2	<b>Good response</b> to the question Clear and relevant ideas Enough detail to show thinking about the topic
Score 1	<b>Some response</b> relevant to the question Ideas not completely clear because writing is too brief Little detail
Score 0	<b>No response</b> , or very minimal Insufficient to score, information is incoherent Illegible, incomprehensible, numbers, copy of question Solely in a foreign language
