Newspaper Headlines: German Anti-Semitism

April 7, 1933 – Jews dismissed from government jobs

July 14, 1935 – Jews may not hold office or vote

September 15, 1935 – The Nuremberg Laws

November 9, 1938 – Jewish boy kills German official! Kristallnacht! Anti-Semitic riots in

Germany and Austria! Synagogues Destroyed! Shops looted!

November 12, 1938 - 26,000 Jews arrested and sent to Concentration Camps!

November 12, 1938 – Nazis force Jews to scrub streets

November 15, 1938 - All Jewish children expelled from German public schools

November 15, 1940 - Jewish ghettos established in occupied Poland

November 15, 1940 – Warsaw ghetto in Poland sealed off.

September 15, 1941 – Jews forced to wear the Star of David throughout Germany and all occupied territory

October 14, 1941 – Deportation of German Jews to extermination camps begin
