+1 Pathway Reporting Codes

Humanities (HUM)

- If a student passes both the US History Regents Examination and the Global History and Geography Regents Examination, districts should report the student with **HUM** as the pathway.
- Students who have not taken advantage of pathway flexibility should always be coded a HUM. Even students who pass additional assessments beyond the required assessments should be coded a HUM if as part of their assessment history they have passed both the Global History and Geography Regents Examination and the US History Regents Examination.

Humanities – Alt (HUMALT)

- If a student passes *either* the US History Regents Examination or the Global History and Geography Regents Examination *and* passes one additional Department-approved English or Social Studies assessment, districts should report the student with **HUMALT** as the pathway.

ARTS (ARTS)

- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and passes an approved ARTS (Dance, Music, Theater, Visual and Media Arts) assessment as their +1 pathway assessment they should be coded with the ARTS pathway code.

Career and Technical Education (CTE)

- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and passes an Department Approved Technical Assessment (CTE) as their +1 pathway they should be coded with the CTE pathway code.

Career Development Occupational Studies (CDOS)

- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and completes the requirements for the CDOS Commencement Credential as their +1 Pathway, they should be coded with the CDOS pathway code.

Languages Other than English (LOTE)

- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and passes an Department Approved Bi-literacy (LOTE) assessment as their +1 pathway, they should be coded with the LOTE pathway code.

STEM- Science (STEMSCIENCE) & STEM-MATH (STEMMATH)

- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and passes an additional science Regents Examination or Department Approved Alternative examination in Science as their +1 pathway they should be coded with the STEMSCIENCE pathway code.
- If a student passes only one social studies Regents Examination as a part of their 4 required Regents Examinations, and passes an additional math Regents Examination or Department Approved Alternative examination in Math as their +1 pathway they should be coded with the STEMMATH pathway code.

More than one +1 Pathway

- If a student passes more than one assessment (other than a second Social Studies) in addition to the 4 required assessments, the student should be reported with whichever pathway code (except HUM or NONE) with which the student mostly closely associates.
- Example: ELA, Math, Living Environment, US History + Geometry, Earth Science

Choose: STEMMATH or STEMSCIENCE
