**Program Services** (in Programs Fact template):

**LEP:**

**Students with Interrupted Formal Education (SIFE)** – (code **1232**)

Indicates a student who, in addition to having been identified as LEP, also:

- comes from a home where a language other than English is spoken and enter a school in the US after grade two; and
- has had at least two years less schooling than his or her peers; and
- functions at least two years below expected grade level in reading and in mathematics in their native language and/or in English due to lack of schooling (e.g. student may or may not be pre-literate (not yet literate) in their native language).

This is a district-level service.

**Higher Education:**

**Liberty Partnerships Program (LPP)** – (code **4004**) Indicates participation in the Liberty Partnerships Program, which provides collaborative pre-collegiate/school dropout prevention programs that support at-risk youth in completing secondary school and prepare those students for successful transition into postsecondary education or onto a career path. This is a district-level service.

**Science and Technology Education Program (STEP)** - (code **4015**) Indicates participation in the Science and Technology Entry Program, which prepares minority, historically underrepresented, or economically disadvantaged secondary school students for entry into postsecondary degree programs in scientific, technical, health-related fields, and the licensed professions. This is a district-level service.

**Reason for ending code (CTE):**

**Leave CTE with the intention of continuing later** (code **680**) - to identify students who plan to continue the program, but may be skipping a semester or a year.
