 - ➔ End enrollment for 8294 (Code 8316) – when student ends residency or ages out
 - ➔ Grade - Full-day Kindergarten (KF), Half-day Kindergarten (KH)
 - ➔ Course – State and local code
 - i. 3-8 ELA/math, 4/8 science, 5/8 social studies
 - ii. Courses that end in a Regents exam
