Course Instructor Assignment (CIA) And Student Class Entry Exit (SCEE)

Reminders

- Use unique sections when reporting courses/sections in a building.
- Instruction coming to a school from another district/BOCES can be reported using the Itinerant indicator in Staff Snapshot for the teacher and using the Course Delivery Method in Course Instructor Assignment (e.g. distance learning).
- Librarian Code 99000 – Reported in CIA would not need a SCEE record.
- Use the Special Ed and ENL Indicators for staff.
- Districts should be able to start moving Course Instructor Assignment and Student Class Entry in the fall.

Course Instructor Assignment

Reminders

Courses are reported by the BOCES, charter school or school district offering the course.

Field 18 - Primary Instruction Language Indicator (e.g. ENGLISH, SPANISH, CHINESE)
NYS Required Field. Use codes in the language look-up table.
This will allow school districts to identify courses taught in Bilingual situations.

New for 2019-20 – Districts should be able to report by February.

Field 20 – Incidental Teaching Assignment Indicator – Districts and BOCES can select one course/section that each teacher can teach outside their certification area (Y). All courses must be identified with a Y or N.

Notes: 1. BOCES DS approval is required. <http://www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/resteachers/employmentissues.html#incidental>
2. For 2019-20, Districts and BOCES will continue to identify “Incidental” assignments in the TAA application as the official source.

AP & IB Course & Assessment Codes

- All Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate courses must be reported with their respective assessments.
-
- Districts should only be reporting AP and IB courses approved by the College Board and IB.
 - New assessment codes are often created each year and made available on the vendor Add/Delete document <http://www.p12.nysed.gov/irs/vendors/home.html> . These should be made available to districts.
 - Districts should be ready to load AP & IB Assessment data when they receive results from IB and the College Board in July and before the NYSED data warehouse closes in August. Vendors should be prepared to assist as needed by the beginning of July.

Changes For 2019-20

Career and Technical Ed (CTE)

- Only report Program Fact data for students in NYSED-approved CTE programs <http://www.p12.nysed.gov/cte/ctepolicy/approved.html>

- “Enrollee” will no longer be a program intensity code. Only report “Participant” or “Concentrator.”
- Two new course codes that may be associated with a student’s CTE Program Fact record related to Work-based Learning.
- CTE Program providers (those who deliver the program) will report the following SIRS data associated with the CTE program (Program Fact, Course Instructor Assignment, Student Class Entry Exit, Student Class Grade Detail, Assessment Fact).
- Programs must offer the opportunities for “work-based learning.”

Participants And Concentrators

The Program Intensity of “enrollee” has been discontinued. Program Intensity will only be reported for “Participants” and “Concentrators” beginning in 2019-20.

CTE Experiences For Middle-level Students

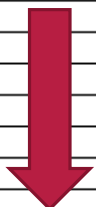
*In 2017 the Board of Regents made a decision to **expand the potential availability of CTE experiences for Middle Level students** to include Business, Agriculture, Health Occupations and Trade and Technical Education in addition to Technology Education and Family and Consumer Sciences. The action allows school districts to offer coursework in any of the 6 CTE content areas to fulfill the 1.75 units of required CTE study in grades 7 and 8. The action does not allow teachers to teach areas outside their area of certification. For example, a teacher certified in Business Education is not permitted to teach the Home and Career Skills curriculum.*
