

SUNY/CUNY Eligible Teacher Preparation Programs

As part of the Smart Schools Bond Investment Plan submission, districts which budget expenditures in the Classroom Learning Technology category of the Smart Schools Bond Act (SSBA) have been asked to contact the SUNY/CUNY school whose **teacher preparation program** supplies the largest number of the district's new teachers. The goal is to develop an on-going collaboration with the teacher preparation institutions that will result in innovative uses of the educational technology purchased with SSBA funds and expand best practices at the intersection of pedagogy and educational technology around the State.

The Smart Schools Investment Plan (SSIP) currently asks for the name of the SUNY/CUNY teacher preparation program you have contacted, along with contact information for the person who is authorized to enter into this collaborative effort.

The following SUNY/CUNY schools have teacher preparation programs supplying teachers to districts across New York State. Of course, you may also consult with other higher educational institutions; however, please ensure you contact one of these eligible institutions which supplies the largest number of the district's new teachers and/or is in nearby proximity to your school or district and enter their contact information in your SSIP:
