<p align="center">Panel Review of Full Application</p> <p>The Full Application will be screened by NYSED for completeness before being accepted and sent for full evaluation by review panels. <i>(Incomplete applications will not be accepted).</i></p>		March - April	September
<p align="center">Phase III: Capacity Interviews</p> <p>NYSED conducts interviews with qualified applicant groups and proposed boards of trustees. <i>(If applicable, CMO representatives may be included in capacity interview).</i></p>		April 7 – May 9	September 22 – October 10
