I am writing to notify you that the Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 19, 2010, approved the following revisions to the initial charter of the Achievement First Endeavor Charter School:

- Increase enrollment in grades 5 through 9 from 289 to 374 students.
- Expand the charter to create a high school division to serve grades 9 through 12.
- Create a co-located high school program with Achievement First Crown Heights Charter School.
- Execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Achievement First Crown Heights Charter School, clarifying the roles and responsibilities of each BoT in creating and managing the co-located high school program.
