Dear Mr. Shobowale:

I am writing to notify you that the Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 11, 2011, voted to approve the following revision to the initial charter of the Leadership Preparatory Ocean Hill Charter School, submitted by the Board of Trustees of the State University of New York:

- To increase its current charter enrollment to reflect the following:
  - in the 2010-2011 school year, an increase from 116 students in Kindergarten through first grade to 145 students in the same grades;
  - in the 2011-2012 school year, an increase from 171 students in Kindergarten through second grade to 232 students in the same grades; and
  - in the 2012-2013 school year, an increase from 223 students in Kindergarten through third grade to 313 students in the same grades.
