Dear Ms. Robinson:

I am writing to notify you that the Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 11, 2011, voted to approve and issue the first renewal charter of the Achievement First Endeavor Charter School, submitted by the Chancellor of the city school district of the City of New York with the following condition:

“The school must demonstrate improved student achievement by scoring in the 25th percentile or above of all schools on the NYC DOE Progress Report within one year after renewal, in the 50th percentile or above of all schools on the NYC DOE Progress Report within two years after renewal, and in the 75th percentile or above of all schools on the NYC DOE Progress Report in each of the 3rd, 4th, and 5th years after renewal.”

The Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 11, 2011 also voted to approve the following revision to the first renewal charter of the Achievement First Endeavor Charter School, submitted by the Chancellor of the city school district of the City of New York:

- Grade configuration by adding K-4 to become a K-12 school with an enrollment of 966 students at capacity
