This notice is to inform you that on September 22, 2010, the New York State Board of Regents received eleven applications to establish charter schools as listed on the chart attached. These applications will be reviewed for action at the December 2010 meeting of the Board of Regents. Full application materials may be viewed at www.p12.nysed.gov/psc/startcharter.

Please note that pursuant to Education Law section 2857(1), the New York City Department of Education is required to hold a public hearing to solicit comments from the community in connection with the foregoing applications. As per 8 NYCRR 119.4 (which became effective on July 31, 2007), this hearing, which is required to be held within the community potentially impacted by the above charter school, must be held within 30 days of your receipt of this letter, and written confirmation that this hearing was held must be sent to the New York State Education Department Charter School Office no later than the business day next following the hearing. Copies of any and all written records or comments generated from this hearing, if any, should also be sent to the Charter School Office within 15 business days after the hearing. Please let my office know when this hearing will be held by forwarding a copy of the hearing notice to the Charter School Office.
