Dear Ms. Noel:

I am writing to notify you that the Board of Regents, at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 19, 2010, approved the following revisions to the initial charter of the Riverton Street Charter School:

- Partner with National Heritage Academies, Inc. as an EMO.
- Amend the grade configuration to serve students in grades K through 3 in 2010-2011 rather than the previously approved grades K through 1, thereby increasing 2010-2011 enrollments from 100 students to 196 students.
- Amend the enrollment for the remaining four years of the charter term:
  - 2010-11: K-3: 100 to 196
  - 2011-12: K-4: 150 to 248
  - 2012-13: K-5: 200 to 418
  - 2013-14: K-5: 250 to 496
  - 2014-15: K-5: 300 to 574
