

**COMPENSATORY SAFETY NET OPTION EXAMPLES**

The following are provided only as examples. For each example, it is presumed that the student has achieved a passing grade for the course(s) and has a satisfactory attendance rate, in accordance with the district's or school's attendance policy, for the course in the subject area of the Regents examination in which he or she received a score of 45-54.

**Student A: Student may use the compensatory option to graduate with a local diploma.**

**Student B: Student may use the compensatory option to graduate with a local diploma.**

Required Regents Exam	Score	Rationale
Comprehensive English	53 Appealed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student earned a score of at least 55 on both the English and mathematics exams.</li> <li>• The student successfully appealed scores between 52-54 on the English and Global History exams. Student's score of 86 on the mathematics exam compensates for his score of 49 on the U.S. History exam.</li> </ul>

**Student C: Student may not use the compensatory option or other safety net options for students with disabilities (i.e., 55-64 low pass option, 55-64 low pass option with appeal or the superintendent determination option) to graduate with a local diploma.**

Comprehensive English	50	Student did not receive a minimum score of 55 on both the Regents ELA and math exams or successfully appeal a score between 52 and 54.

**Student D: Student may use the compensatory option to graduate with a local diploma.**

Comprehensive English	61	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student earned a score of at least 55 on both the English and mathematics exams.</li> <li>• Student's score of 78 on the Science exam compensates for his score of 49 on the Global History.</li> <li>• The student successfully appealed a score between 52-54 on the U.S. History &amp; Government exam.</li> </ul>

**Student E: Student may not use the compensatory option to graduate with a local diploma. However, the student's parent may request a Superintendent Determination to determine if the student has otherwise demonstrated competency in Global History and Science and has met the requirements for graduation with a local diploma.**

Comprehensive English	61	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student earned a score of at least 55 on both the English and mathematics exams.</li> <li>• The student received a successful appeal of the score of 52 in U.S. History &amp; Government.</li> <li>• The student did not earn a score of 65 or above to compensate for the 50 on the Science exam or the 49 on the Global History exam.</li> </ul>

**Student F: Student may use the compensatory option to graduate with a local diploma using the 4 + CDOS Pathway Option.**

Comprehensive English	65	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student earned a score of at least 55 on the English and successfully appealed the score of 53 on the Math exam.</li> <li>• Student's score of 65 on the English exam compensates for his score of 50 on the Global History &amp; Geography exam.</li> <li>• The student passed four Regents exams (one in each of the four discipline areas of math, English, science, and social studies) and met the requirements for the CDOS Commencement Credential.</li> </ul>
